Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be currently enrolled as a student.
- have completed at least one full year of undergraduate study.
- have a good academic record – generally this means a GPA (or equivalent) of 2.75, B average or better (A lower GPA will require two additional letters of support from your University).

Upon successful application:

Students will be sent a Letter of Offer. The Offer will request acceptance in writing, and payment of tuition fees (if applicable) and Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) – an Australian Government requirement. Once these are received, a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) will be issued. Students then need to provide details of the CoE to their nearest Australian Embassy/High Commission/Consulate in order to apply for a student visa to study in Australia.

What to submit / checklist

- This application form – all sections completed clearly and legibly.
- Original official academic transcripts from your home university or college – certified English language translations if applicable.
- Certified* evidence of English language competency if English is not your first language, e.g. TOEFL, IELTS.
- Statement of Purpose – see section 2 for more information.
